1. B.A. HONOURS:

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2019/2018/2017) are eligible for apply for Honours course in Bengali/English/History/Philosophy/Political Science/Sanskrit/Sociology provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination.

2. B.A. GENERAL:

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2019/2018/2017) are eligible to apply for General course with subjects Bengali/English/History/Philosophy/Political Science/Sanskrit/Sociology/Music provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

N.B. Candidates passed vocational course can apply in General courses only.

3. B. Sc. HONOURS:

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2019/2018/2017) are eligible to apply for Honours course with subjects Chemistry/Geography/Mathematics/Nutrition/Physics/Zoology/Botany/Aquaculture Management provided that the candidate must have passed with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

(For Physics Honours it is mandatory with Mathematics subject with pass mark in 10+2)

4. B. Sc. GENERAL:

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2019/2018/2017) are eligible to apply for General course with subjects Zoology/Botany/Chemistry/Geography/Nutrition/Mathematics/Physics/Physiology/Aquaculture Mgt. provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

5. B. Com. HONOURS:

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2019/2018/2017) are eligible to apply for Honours course with subject provided that the candidate must have passed with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

6. B. Com. GENERAL:

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2019/2018/2017) are eligible to apply for General course with subjects provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

N.B. A Candidates Passing 10+2 Level in the year 2016 OR Earlier with above mentioned criteria can also apply through ONLINE MODE after getting SPECIAL PERMISSION from the Secretary, U.G. Council, Vidyasagar University, Midnapur.

- It is also mentioned that the admission is provisional unless or until the candidate is registered to Vidyasagar University through this college. Any suppression of facts or wrong production of facts, found in future, will cancel the admission.

2. Register yourself by visiting the said website, get user name and pass word through SMS / email
3. Login using username and password
4. Follow Step-1, Fill up details of personal information,
5. Follow Step-2, and Step-3 to entry, the details of last examination passed and Upload your scanned photograph, signature, Mark sheet of 10+2 Standard and Caste/category certificate if any. Follow Step-4 fill up the subjects for which you want to apply

6. Make payment through online mode as arranged in the admission portal.
7. Submit the form in online mode finally. No edit is allowed after final submission.
8. Take the print out of submitted form, paste photograph, signed in appropriate places and keep it with you till verification after admission.
